REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR CORONERS

Pursuant to Section 802.5 of the Business and Professions Code: "When a coroner receives information that is based on findings that were reached by, or documented and approved by a board-certified or board-eligible pathologist indicating that a death may be the result of a physician's, physician assistants' or podiatrist's gross negligence or incompetence, a report shall be filed with the Medical Board of California, ...or the California Board of Podiatric Medicine or the Physician Assistant Board."
