3. During Agenda Item **2** – Public Comments on Items not on the Agenda, the Board has limited the total public comment period via teleconference to twenty minutes. Therefore, after twenty minutes, no further comments will be accepted. Each person will be limited to three minutes per agenda item.
4. During public comment on any other agenda item, a total of ten minutes will be allowed for comments via the teleconference line. After ten minutes, no further comments will be accepted. Each person will be limited to three minutes per agenda item.
5. Comments for those in attendance at the meeting will have the same time limitations as those identified above for individuals on the teleconference line.

The audience will be given appropriate opportunities to comment on any issue presented in open session before the Board, but the President may apportion available time among those who wish to speak.
