Business and Professions Code 2220(a)



- ▶ Requires the Board to investigate the circumstances underlying Business and Professions Code section 805 or 805.01 reports within 30 days to determine if an interim suspension order (ISO) should be issued.

Business and Professions Code 2220(a)



September 1, 2015 to December 31, 2017

805/805.01 reports received	234
No ISO warranted	195
Possible ISO	39
• Complaints still open	28
• Referred for ISO	8
• Complaints closed-no ISO	3

805 Process Enhancements



- ▶ Creation of educational letter

- ▶ Creation of BreZE activity codes to track cases determined to be possible ISOs and those where educational letters were issued
