PROGRAM UPDATE:

Although the Licensing Program continues to have some vacancies, work has been redistributed to lead staff and management to ensure goals are met. Management will continue to utilize all resources available to continue to meet the goals with no overtime. The Licensing Program is currently reviewing and updating existing procedures to ensure work is completed in the most efficient manner.

The Licensing Program is currently in its busiest time of year when residents who are training in California require a medical license before the end of June. The management team will continue to be proactive in an effort to maintain all goals while meeting the needs of the applicants and the training programs.

The Licensing Program's strategic goal for reviewing Physician's and Surgeon's License applications is within 45 days of receipt by the Board. Licensing staff continues to exceed this goal for the third quarter of fiscal year 2016/2017. During the third quarter, the average number of days to complete the initial review of a physician's and surgeon's license application is **29 days**. In addition, licensing staff continues to process all incoming mail within an average of **7 days**.

The Licensing Program has issued 4,889 medical licenses since the beginning of the fiscal year 2016/2017. This is an increase of 511 medical licenses compared to the same time period last fiscal year.

A detailed listing of the Licensing Program's statistics is included following this report.

STAFFING:

The Licensing Program has hired two associate governmental program analysts, Pati Medina and Rhonda Baldo. Each have over 20 years of experience with the Board and they will continue to be an asset to the Licensing Program.

The Licensing Program is actively recruiting for four positions: staff services analyst for the international medical graduate application review; management services technician for the United States/Canada graduate application review; program technician II for the Consumer Information Unit, and an office technician for the Cashiering Unit.

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CONSUMER INFORMATION CENTER:

The Consumer Information Center (CIU) staff continues to work on a comprehensive training manual to ensure staff are fully trained and answer each call efficiently and accurately. CIU staff utilizes specific greeting scripts to ensure each caller receives professional customer service. The CIU supervisor monitors telephone calls weekly to ensure accurate information is being provided to callers. To improve customer service, CIU is now open daily from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., including the lunch hour.

The number of calls answered this quarter increased to 19,516 compared to last quarter of 16,463, which is an 18.5% increase of calls answered by staff. In addition, the number of callbacks have increased this quarter to 6,871 compared to last quarter of 3,994, which is a significant increase of 72% more callbacks made by staff.

SPECIALTY BOARD APPLICATIONS:

The Board has one pending application from a specialty board requesting approval by the Board.

INTERNATIONAL MEDICAL SCHOOLS:

The Licensing Program has seven Self-Assessment Reports pending. Specifically, three are pending initial review by Board staff; one review has been completed and will be forwarded to a medical consultant for review; and three reports are with a medical consultant for review and recommendation. In addition, staff identified 83 international medical schools that have failed to respond to the Board's initial letter and follow-up requests for additional information to continue with the review process to recognize their school in California. Staff has begun sending final letters to these international medical schools in an attempt to obtain the necessary documentation to continue with the review process. If no response is received, their file will be closed and will no longer be in a pending status. An update will be provided at the July 2017 Board meeting.

At a previous Board meeting, Members authorized staff to conduct a site visit of the Medical University of the Americas. The site visit will take place in June 2017 and staff is working on the final approval from the appropriate control agencies to conduct the site visit, as well as the travel arrangements for the site team.

Medical consultant interviews were held on April 3, 2017 and it is expected that the Board will have one additional medical consultant by May 2017 to assist with the review of international medical schools that wish to be recognized in California. Additional medical consultants will be of great assistance to the Licensing Program and will decrease the amount of time it currently takes to determine if an international medical school meets the Board's requirements.
