



Professional Collaboration





Professional Collaboration

- Starts with education and building professional relationships
- CALM Transitions (akin to WA Smooth Transitions)
 - Dialogue for learning
 - Invitation to create agreements
 - Builds cultural competency (on both sides)



Professional Clinical Guidelines

Fundamental expectation in the health care professions

Protects and serves everyone



Education and Training



Education and Training

- Midwives are not doulas! Doh!
- CPM credential is the beginning, entry level
 - Advanced skills
 - Training in communication and handoffs







Elements of Accountability

- Protected peer review
- Incident review (with targeted education)
- Surveys:
 - Patient to hospital
 - Patient to midwife
 - Midwife to hospital
 - Physician to midwife
