An act making appropriations for the support of the government of the State of California and for several public purposes in accordance with the provisions of Section 12 of Article IV of the Constitution of the State of California, to take effect immediately, Budget Bill.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

SB 957, as introduced, Leno. 2012-13 Budget.

This bill would make appropriations for support of state government for the 2012–13 fiscal year.

This bill would declare that it is to take effect immediately as a Budget Bill. Vote: majority. Appropriation: yes. Fiscal committee: yes. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1.00. This act shall be known and may be cited as the 2 "Budget Act of 2012."
- 3 SEC. 1.50. (a) In accordance with Section 13338 of the Government
- 4 Code, as added by Chapter 1284 of the Statutes of 1978, and as amended
- 5 by Chapter 1286 of the Statutes of 1984, it is the intent of the Legislature
- 6 that this act utilize a coding scheme compatible with the Governor's
- Budget and the records of the Controller, and provide for the appropriation
 - of federal funds received by the state and deposited in the State Treasury.
- (b) Essentially, the format and style are as follows:
- 10 (1) Appropriation item numbers have a code which is common to all the state's fiscal systems. The meaning of this common coded item number
- 12 is as follows:
- 13 2720—Organization Code (this code represents the California Highway
- 14 Patrol)
- 15 001—Reference Code (first appropriation for a particular fund for support of each department)
