# Steven M. Thompson Physician Corps Loan Repayment Program (STLRP) - FY 2018-19

- The FY 2018-19 Steven M. Thompson Physician Corps Loan Repayment Program (STLRP) application cycle closed on February 26, 2019.
- HPEF has received 275 applications. Of the 275 applications, 131 applications were ineligible, and 144 applications were scored.
- Approximately 42 physicians will be awarded loan repayment. The total cost of awards from licensure fees and managed care fines and penalty fees is \$4.41 million.
- Thank you to the volunteers from the Medical Board who assisted in scoring applications.
- STLRP award announcements will be sent out in May.

#### HPEF Loan Repayment Awards - FY 2018-19

• For the allied healthcare, nursing and licensed mental health loan repayment programs, HPEF will award 194 healthcare and mental healthcare professionals. The total amount awarded is \$2.16 million.
