SUBJECT: Licensing Program Summary

#### **REQUESTED ACTION:**

This report is intended to provide the Members with an update on the Licensing Program at the Medical Board of California (Board). No action is needed at this time.

### PROGRAM UPDATE:

In October of 2017, Senate Bill 798 (Hill, Chapter 775) was signed by Governor Brown revising the postgraduate training and licensing requirements for physicians and surgeons, and supporting Board's mission of consumer protection.

Effective January 1, 2020, all applicants, regardless of whether the medical school attended was domestic or international, are required to successfully complete 36 months of postgraduate training accredited by either the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME), Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCSPC), or College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC) that includes four months of general medicine. Applicants will need to complete 24 consecutive months of training in the same program in order to be eligible for a physician's and surgeon's license in California.

Additionally, a Postgraduate Training License (PTL) will be required for all residents participating in an ACGME accredited postgraduate training program in California in order to practice medicine as part of their training program. A PTL must be obtained within 180 days after enrollment in the program and will not be required to be renewed. The profile of a holder of a PTL will be displayed on the Board's website for public view. Any resident participating in an ACGME accredited postgraduate training program at the time the law goes in effect, and who is not eligible for licensure, will need a PTL by June 30, 2020, to continue in the training program.

The new PTL applications are available on the Board's website and online through the BreEZe system. To date, the Board has received 64 PTL applications. The Licensing Program (Program) management team and staff continue to work with current applicants and programs on any questions that arise regarding the new postgraduate training requirements.

The Board continues to be proactive in communicating the new 2020 law changes in regards to postgraduate training by updating the Board's website, corresponding with applicants and programs, and sharing information on social media.

The Program continues to meet its application processing goals by reviewing applications and supporting documents within its target timelines – reviewing applications within 30 days and supporting documents within 10 days. All Program staff have received the new procedures and training in regards to the PTL changes.

The Program received and responded to 2,661 emails last quarter from the Program's Webmaster regarding topics such as 2020 postgraduate training changes, continuing medical education, renewals, pocket certificates, and application status.

### <u>DIRECT ONLINE CERTIFICATION SYSTEM (DOCS) PORTAL:</u>

In December 2019, the Program successfully implemented the initial roll-out of the new DOCS Portal with three medical schools to resolve any issues prior to full implementation. The Board has already received and processed documents through the DOCS portal. The Board plans to have the DOCS Portal available and onboard all medical schools and accredited programs in February 2020.

DOCS will allow the Board to electronically receive verification documents from medical schools and postgraduate training programs. DOCS will assist the Board in achieving its strategic goal of eliminating the potential for loss of documentation and streamlining the licensing process. Automating this process will improve customer service and expedite the transition process for an applicant who has completed the required 36-months of postgraduate training.

### LICENSED PHYSICIAN AND DENTISTS FROM MEXICO PILOT PROGRAM:

As reported at the last meeting, the Board has received twenty-nine (29) physician applications and six (6) nonprofit community health center applications. Prior to the issuance of these licenses, the physicians from Mexico must be enrolled in a six-month externship affiliated with a California medical school in good standing that includes working in the nonprofit community health center and a corresponding hospital to ensure that the participant is complying with the established standards for quality assurance. To date, this requirement has not yet been met. The Board continues to work on an Interagency Agreement with an outside entity to conduct the evaluation of the program as required by law.

#### **CONSUMER INFORMATION UNIT:**

The Consumer Information Unit (CIU) handled 16,118 calls in Quarter 2. The average wait time for these calls was five minutes and fifty seconds, with that number dropping to three minutes and twenty-eight seconds during the final two weeks of the quarter. This average wait time represents a significant decrease from previous quarters. The CIU's accomplishments during this period also include maintaining under a 20% transfer rate of complaint calls. This is a direct result of additional training provided by the Enforcement Program to CIU staff. Furthermore, the CIU has been instrumental in successfully providing information to callers related to the 2020 postgraduate training requirements.

### **OUTREACH:**

The Program continues to evaluate its outreach efforts to medical schools, applicants, licensees, and consumers as part of its strategic goal to increase awareness of the Board, its mission, activities, and services. In an effort to prepare medical programs and applicants for the new PTL requirements, the Program provided California program directors a "PTL Requirements Checklist" and information sheet to assist with the 2020 changes and hiring of prospective residents.




