### **REQUESTED ACTION:**

This report is intended to provide the Members with an update on the Licensing Program at the Medical Board of California (Board).

### PROGRAM UPDATE:

In Quarter 4 of Fiscal Year 2022-2023, the Board received 1,890 initial license applications (1,377 Physician's and Surgeon's (P&S) Initial License and Transition applications; 513 Postgraduate Training License (PTL) applications) and issued a total of 2,379 licenses (2,354 P&S licenses and 25 PTLs).

On June 1, 2023, the Board stopped accepting paper applications for the P&S License and successfully transitioned all PTL and P&S License applications to online only. Starting January 1, 2024, the Board will no longer accept documents from medical schools and postgraduate training programs through the mail and submission will be limited to the DOCS portal. This change will signify the complete transition of all PTL and P&S license application documents to electronic submission only and the complete elimination of paper application documents, except for fingerprint hard cards, which further streamlines the process.

Now that the Licensing Program has completed mapping all "could-be" business processes in conjunction with the Department of Consumer Affairs (DCA) Organizational Improvement Office, it is currently evaluating how to implement the "could-be" processes. The Program is determining which changes can be implemented immediately and which ones may require additional time, such as IT-related changes to how third parties electronically transmit applicant information to the Board, such as the Federation of State Medical Board (FSMB). The FSMB will be visiting the Board on October 10, 2023, to provide an overview of FSMB and its products and services and allow for information exchange and discussion to identify ways in which FSMB can work to better support the Board.

Part of the Licensing Program's evaluation includes determining if any changes to licensing and application requirements could create efficiency without compromising public safety. As of August 2023, the Board no longer requires a certified copy of a diploma for PTL and P&S applications because the Board obtains all medical information needed to determine an applicant's eligibility for licensure from the official transcript and the Board's Certificate of Medical Education form. The Board is also updating it's website and online applications to more clearly list documents that do not need to be provided if they are part of the applicant's FSMB Federation Credentials Verification Service (FCVS) profile and primary source verified. These types of changes help eliminate unnecessary deficiencies and reduce the number of documents submitted to the Board to be processed.

The Licensing Program continues to experience high application processing times, which is currently on average 120 days from the date received to the date of the initial review. The Licensing Program hired two Retired Annuitants and is actively recruiting several more to assist with the backlog. The Board is also redirecting staff from other units to provide assistance with processing license applications and is partnering with the DCA to fast track the Licensing Program for two months to assist with processing applications.

### DIRECT ONLINE CERTIFICATION SUBMISSION

As of August 4, 2023, 2,126 postgraduate training programs and 551 medical schools are registered in the Board's DOCS portal. There have been 70,531 documents uploaded to DOCS since its inception.

### **WEBMASTER**

The Licensing Program received 4,100 emails and responded to 3,483 via the Licensing Webmaster in Quarter 4 of the current fiscal year regarding topics, such as application status checks, license renewals, and pocket cards.

### CONSUMER INFORMATION UNIT

In Quarter 4 of FY 2022-2023, the Consumer Information Unit (CIU) received 16,358 calls, with an average wait time of 5:08 minutes. Five of the topics most responded to in CIU during this quarter were application status checks, complaint questions, physician and surgeon application questions, complaint form mail requests, and Physician and Surgeon renewal assistance. The Licensing Program recently hired one Program Technician II in CIU and is actively recruiting to fill its one remaining vacancy.

### **OUTREACH**

In Quarter 4 of FY 2022-2023, the Licensing Program attended three in-person outreach events and provided two virtual outreach presentations at accredited postgraduate training program orientation events where Licensing staff answered application questions and provided feedback.




## Physician's and Surgeon's Licenses Issued\* Four Fiscal Year History

## Postgraduate Training Licenses Issued\* Fiscal Year History







