

Athletic Commission Seeks Ringside Physicians

The California State Athletic Commission (Commission) regulates professional and amateur boxing, kickboxing, and mixed martial arts throughout the state by licensing all participants and supervising the events. The Commission is dedicated to the health, safety and welfare of participants in regulated competitive sporting events through ethical and professional service.

The Commission is currently seeking ringside physicians in Northern California (from San Jose to Redding) to work approximately 10-20 hours per month, mostly on Fridays and Saturdays.

Applicants must possess: (a) a current and unrestricted license issued by the Medical Board of California or the Osteopathic Medical Board of

California and (b) staff privileges in medicine, surgery, or emergency medicine in a general acute care facility accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Health Care Organizations.
