## **Prescription Drug Awareness Month**

SACRAMENTO: The Medical Board of California announces the launch of its campaign promoting March as Prescription Drug Awareness Month.

Senate Concurrent Resolution 8, passed by the Legislature in 2013, designated March as Prescription Drug Awareness Month and encourages individuals to "spread the word – one pill can kill." As of 2011, the Center for Disease Control released data revealing that prescription drug deaths are now the leading cause of accidental deaths outnumbering traffic fatalities. This has become an epidemic. The primary goal of the Medical Board is the protection of consumers, and the Medical Board is determined to make physicians and consumers aware of this epidemic. The Medical Board wants to inform individuals of what they can do to help reverse this trend.

The Medical Board has a video available for broadcast hosted by Board Member Dr. Michael Bishop. This video addresses what physicians can do to help prevent prescription drug abuse. In addition there will soon be PSAs available in both English and Spanish that will address what the consumer can do.
