San Rafael Physician Surrenders License Based on Unprofessional Conduct

Sacramento – Dr. Michael Roger Chiarottino has surrendered his medical license effective June 10, 2015. Chiarottino had been under an Interim Suspension Order (ISO) issued by an administrative law judge since May 5, 2014, based on criminal charges filed by the Marin County Superior Court on April 10, 2014, accusing Chiarottino of several violations, including driving under the influence of a drug, child endangerment and possession of controlled substances. On August 26, 2014, the Board filed a First Amended Accusation for the criminal convictions and for gross negligence, repeated negligent acts, incompetence, excessive prescribing, and inadequate record keeping, in the care and treatment provided to five patients.
