Shasta County Physician Surrenders License to Practice Medicine

SACRAMENTO – The Medical Board has adopted the surrender of Timothy William Wilkins' license to practice medicine in the state of California effective September 6, 2016. "The Medical Board's primary mission is public protection and this action reflects the Board's ongoing commitment to that mission," said the Board's executive director Kimberly Kirchmeyer.

In summary, in Shasta County Superior Court on February 23, 2016, Wilkins pled no contest to four felony counts of unlawful sexual intercourse with a minor, a misdemeanor for providing lewd materials to a minor and two misdemeanor counts of contributing to the delinquency of a minor. He was sentenced to 210 days in county jail and three years' probation with a court order not to practice medicine while on probation, in addition to other conditions. An Accusation based upon the convictions was filed on August 3, 2016.
