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San Marino Physician Surrenders License to Practice Medicine

SACRAMENTO – The Medical Board has adopted the stipulated surrender of Boyao Huang’s license to practice medicine in the state of California, effective December 30, 2016. “The Medical Board’s primary mission is public protection and this action reflects the Board’s ongoing commitment to that mission,” said the Board’s executive director Kimberly Kirchmeyer.

In summary, on August 16, 2016, an Accusation was filed against Huang. The Accusation was based on a May 5, 2016 criminal conviction in the United States District Court for the Central District of California, which involved four counts of felony health care fraud. The Accusation also charged acts of dishonesty and unprofessional conduct related to the conviction. The documents pertaining to these actions can be found at:
